Delighted in - Isaiah 42:1 “Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him and he will bring justice to the nations.”

Delivered - 2 Timothy 4:18 “The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen.”

New self - Ephesians 4:22-24 “You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; 23to be made new in the attitude of your minds; 24and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.”

No longer children - Ephesians 4:14-15 “Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. 15Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ.”

No longer slaves to sin - Romans 6:6 “For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—”

Not given a spirit of fear - 2 Timothy 1:7 “For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.”

Not my own - 1 Corinthians 6:19 “Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;”

Noticed with loving concern - Psalm 33:13-14 “From heaven the LORD looks down and sees all mankind; 14 from his dwelling place he watches all who live on earth—”

Object of mercy - Romans 9:23 “What if he did this to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory—”

Obtained an inheritance - Ephesians 1:11 “In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will,”

Partaker of Christ - Hebrews 3:14 “We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly till the end the confidence we had at first.”

Power of God behind me - Philippians 3:21 "who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body."

Prayed for - Luke 22:32 "But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

Prayers go up before God - Revelation 8:4 "The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of the saints, went up before God from the angel's hand."

Prepared beforehand for glory - Romans 9:23 "What if he did this to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory—"

Presented to God holy, blameless - Colossians 1:22 "But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—"

Pressing forward - Philippians 3:14 "I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus."

Priest - 1 Peter 2:9 "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light."

Sent - John 20:21 "Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

Temple of the living God - 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19 "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? 6:19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;"

Thought about - Psalm 139:17-18 "How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! 18 Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you."

Transferred to kingdom of His Son - Colossians 1:13 "For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves,"
